



STATE FIRE MARSHAL FF I TRAINING GRANT

Registration deadline December 5, 2018

Funding based on grant approval.



Firefighter I

(Please note the FF1 curriculum no longer includes EMS and EVOC. Please see the explanation below.)*

*** Effective January 1, 2018 per the ODPS, the 8 hours of the EMS and 16 hours of EVOC will no longer be included in the FF1 class.**

If you do not currently hold an EMT, Medic, or 1st Responder card, you will have to enroll in the 8-hour EMS training as an additional required class prior to starting the FF1 class.

If you have not taken a current EVOC course (within 12 months of the class start date), you will have to enroll in the 16-hour EVOC class prior to the ODPS releasing your FF1 certification card. You can start the FF1 class and take the ODPS FF1 test prior to taking the EVOC, but the ODPS will hold your FF1 card until they receive your EVOC card.

In the schedule below, you will see a start date and end date that will include EMS, FF1, and EVOC even though they are now considered 3 classes. You will enroll in the classes that you need to enroll in and attend the appropriate classes as scheduled.

Program Pre-reqs: WorkKeys testing (\$60.00 paid for at the time of the test) and a copy of high school diploma/GED®.

Firefighter I training will include department organization, safety, fire behavior, portable extinguishers, personal protective equipment, tools, ladders, fire hose, appliances and streams, overhaul, rescue and water supplies. Train on fire alarm and communications, forcible entry, ventilation, ropes, control, salvage, cause and origin, detection, alarm and suppression systems, prevention, public education, cause determination, building construction, emergency medical care and hazardous materials. Personal protective equipment required.

Upon successful completion of this course, students will take the Firefighter I certification test and be prepared for entry-level positions in firefighting. The Firefighter I test will be scheduled at C-TEC upon successful completion of class.

Total cost of the FF1 class is \$1582.00 and will be paid for by the State Fire Marshal Grant upon successful completion of the Fire I class, pending funding/grant approval. See additional course fees on the 2nd page for registration in EMS & EVOC courses.

Note: Student must successfully complete the program to receive the grant through C-TEC. If the student does not successfully complete the FF1 course, the student or sponsoring department will be responsible for all costs related to the FF1 program as noted on the enrollment agreement form.

8 hours of EMS--\$72.00, January 9 &12.

Student will be responsible for payment at the time of enrollment. If opting out of EMS, a copy of your card will be required at the time of enrollment.

16 hours of EVOC--\$144.00. Student will be responsible for payment at the time of enrollment. EVOC will be offered within the April 8, 10 & 13 timeframe. If opting out of EVOC class, a copy of your EVOC course completion will be required before the ODPS will issue you a FF1 card.

The student will also be responsible for cost of the FF1 class entrance requirements. This includes WorkKeys pre-testing, BCI/FBI background check and completion of the NFPA physical form and 8 hours of EMS and 16 hours of EVOC as applicable. These items are not covered under the FF1 grant and will be the responsibility of the student.

FIREFIGHTER CLASS REQUIREMENTS:

- Capable of strenuous physical activity
- No facial hair (mustache acceptable)
- Submit physical form on first day of class (form on website)
- NFPA approved fire equipment and gear; gear can be rented at www.rentbunkergear.com or call (800) 476-4658
- Valid Driver's License
- Completion of NIMS 100+700 (copy of certificate required)
- Must be at least 17 years old and a high school senior
- Must be in department uniform or navy blue C-TEC shirt and pants with black shoes; refer to the EMT and Firefighter Student handbooks
- BCI/FBI background check, code#109578, will be required before clinical time; please have your BCI/FBI mailed to: C-TEC, attn.: Earl Miller, 150 Price Road, Newark, Ohio 43055

Applicant shall not have been convicted of any of the following:

- Any felony
- A misdemeanor committed in the course of practice
- A misdemeanor involving moral turpitude

Background checks are only valid up to one year prior to the start of class.

All required forms and schedules are on the [C-TEC website at www.c-tec.edu](http://www.c-tec.edu). Go to Adult Education Programs, then Professional Firefighter and once there, click on Additional Resources. All forms should be printed prior to the first class.

Any student funded by a department will need to present a letter of intent to pay from the chief at the time of enrollment. Fax letter of intent to (740) 364-2303. To enroll, call registration at (740) 364-2261. Note: There will be an additional \$10 testing fee for all proctored retests.
