STUDENT DRIVING/PARKING REGULATIONS

1. All students who drive to school must secure and maintain a valid C-TEC Parking Permit. This decal is issued through the Dean of Students' Office and **must be appropriately displayed facing outwardly on the rearview mirror of the vehicle at all times. It must be displayed no later than September 6, 2020.**
2. You must enter the parking lots via the appropriate entrances from Price Road. **DO NOT DRIVE IN FRONT OF THE BUILDING; THIS AREA IS FOR BUSES ONLY.** When you arrive, come **immediately** into the building. Students are prohibited from loitering in any place, public or private, including the C-TEC student parking lot, before or after school. No student may return to his/her car without permission of an administrator.
3. Do not exceed **10 mph** on school grounds.
4. Do not exceed **20 mph** in the school zone that parallels C-TEC on Price Road.
5. Do not park in the spaces reserved for Adult students and staff, Cosmetology patrons, or Administrative staff.
6. Student drivers **are prohibited** from driving through the **Sherwood Downs residential area** to access 21st Street, King Road, etc.
7. All drivers **will stop to allow buses to depart**--buses are always given preference.
8. Students shall practice common courtesy to other student drivers as lanes merge into main exit lane.
9. Student drivers shall adhere to C-TEC's "good neighbor policy" by refraining from playing loud music, revving engines and peeling tires upon exiting the lot.
10. Students are not permitted to ride in the back of a pickup truck under any circumstances.
11. Make sure you have read the section in the Student Handbook regarding Student Use of Automobiles. It is important you understand that the administration shall reserve the right to, upon reasonable cause, inspect and search any motor vehicle and confiscate prohibited material. If deemed necessary, the administration may request the assistance of law enforcement officials utilizing a canine unit. Additionally, since the student lot is not monitored during the school day, the C-TEC Board and administration will not assume responsibility for damage to, or any loss related to, a privately owned vehicle.

NOTE: In addition to the regulations mentioned above, I understand that I must:

1. obtain a valid C-TEC driving permit and **appropriately display it facing outwardly on the rearview mirror of the vehicle at all times**
2. maintain a valid Ohio Driver's License
3. maintain liability insurance on the vehicle
4. maintain and use safety belts that are properly installed
5. **student vehicles must be free of any signs, decals, ornaments, or other objects that are offensive, profane, obscene, degrading, gang or hate group related, or that are disruptive to the school process**
6. comply with all other driving and vehicle safety laws of the State of Ohio
7. comply with the driving rules and regulations of C-TEC

I understand that my vehicle may be towed at my expense for failure to obtain and/or properly display a driving permit on any vehicle driven to school. **I have read the regulations as well as the regulations in the C-TEC Student Handbook, and I agree to comply.** I understand that these regulations are in effect on the way to and from school, both before school begins and after dismissal time on a daily basis. I understand that my driving privilege may be removed immediately for any violation or noncompliance.
